Have you seen all the blocks out there that are fussy cut? Fussy cutting is when you deliberately cut a fabric a certain way to highlight a motif (picture or print). Then you can magically combine these pieces into a block that can result in a secondary design within the block due to the fussy cutting. This technique is often used in English Paper Piecing (EPP) projects. Kathy has so many tips to share, you might not want to miss out on this exciting class if you are interested in any of the wonderful EPP or fussy cut block design projects shown on social media or seen at quilt shows.



Hand piecing is one of the most relaxing ways to sew. It's easy to bring with you in carpool lines, waiting rooms, or just to your favorite chair. It also makes it easy as pie to match points ~ that's an added bonus! You'll learn the basics of marking lines, sewing seams, pressing, and, yes, matching points!

The pattern we're using is designed for charm packs. You may choose to cut your own squares; either option is fine. One of the samples I'll show you was made with 2.5" mini charms. It will make a fun table-topper.

*Note: There will be some fabric cutting required before class. If you need help with that, please let me know.*



We will focus on the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam making blocks like piano keys, bricks and checkerboards and then moving on to half/square triangles and flying geese. You only need to know how to sew a straight stitch to attend this class.


